## Bangor Area High School Bands

### *Officers*

Any student who fits the criteria and wishes to be considered for these positions must compose a brief (200 word) essay illustrating why he/she believes he/she would be a strong candidate for his/her chosen officer position (Due **Friday, May 17, 2019**). Additionally, elections for President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Grade Representatives will be held on **Thursday, May 23, 2019** and **Friday, May 24, 2019**.

Positions must be held by a student who is a member of Symphonic Band or Concert Band, and who is also a member of Marching Band.

*Elected Positions: President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Grade Representative*

#### President - Must be a Senior in 2019-2020

- Organize and lead monthly meetings of student officers
- Prepare and deliver a student report at monthly Slater Band Boosters meetings
- Organize and lead student morale/spirit activities
- Assist with the daily cleaning of the Band room, including organizing chairs, stands, and percussion equipment
- Assist with distributing student fundraising orders upon delivery
- Assist with Marching Band uniform distribution

#### Vice-President – Must be a Junior or Senior in 2019-2020

- Attend monthly meetings of student officers
- Deliver a student report at monthly Slater Band Boosters meetings if President is unable to attend
- Organize and lead the set up and tear down of the stage before and after performances
- Organize and lead the loading and unloading of the equipment truck
- Assist with the daily cleaning of the Band room, including organizing chairs, stands, and percussion equipment
- Assist with distributing student fundraising orders upon delivery
- Assist with Marching Band uniform distribution

#### Secretary – Must be a Sophomore, Junior, or Senior in 2019-2020

- Attend and keep minutes of monthly meetings of student officers
- Assist band director with record keeping
- Take attendance at Marching Band rehearsals
- Assist with the daily cleaning of the Band room, including organizing chairs, stands, and percussion equipment
- Assist with distributing student fundraising orders upon delivery
- Assist with Marching Band uniform distribution

#### Treasurer – Must be a Sophomore, Junior, or Senior in 2019-2020

- Attend monthly meetings of student officers
- Assist band director with paperwork regarding student accounts
- Assist with the daily cleaning of the Band room, including organizing chairs, stands, and percussion equipment
- Assist with distributing student fundraising orders upon delivery
- Assist with Marching Band uniform distribution

#### Grade Representative – Must be a Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, or Senior in 2019-2020

- Attend monthly meetings of student officers
- Serve as a liaison to the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade class

Take attendance at Symphonic Band and Concert Band rehearsals  
Assist with the daily cleaning of the Band room, including organizing chairs, stands, and percussion equipment  
Assist with distributing student fundraising orders upon delivery  
Assist with Marching Band uniform distribution

*Non-Elected Position: Librarian*

Librarian – Must be a Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, or Senior in 2019-2020

A librarian is someone who is detail-oriented, hard working, and organized. The band director will choose four students to fulfill the duties of librarian for the duration of next school year. These duties include, but are not limited to: copying parts, distributing/collecting music for all ensembles, maintaining an organized library/work space, and updating the band library's database. Librarians should be available to assist with these tasks during the summer, as well as before and/or after school.
